**Seminar:
Financial Damages Analysis**

Prof. Dr. Stefan Weber, LL.M. (Harvard)

- Seminar Description:* Arbitral decisions frequently involve numerical calculation, advanced analytical concepts or quantitative techniques. The interfaces between matters of law and matters of fact, though, often are not clear cut, e.g. concerning the assessment method, or the assessment procedure. The numerical assessment may even be more complex than the underlying legal analysis. Such assessment may concern a wide range of concepts including discounted cash flow (DCF), cost of capital, discount rates, compound interest, loss of profits.
- The working assumption in this seminar is that participants will have no particular financial knowledge.
- The seminar will be held at the Europa-Institut and in Paris in the premises of the ICC Court. It will start with an introduction to the ICC Court. Professional visits, e.g. to the OECD or a leading international arbitration law firm are planned.
